Below is an explanation of the green, yellow and red day. Each child will participate in a behavioral management system in which they will have their name on a chart. Accompanying the chart will be a green, yellow and red piece of paper. Each color paper symbolizes the child's behavior.

Green-behavior is positive, child is following classroom rules, procedures and directions

Yellow-child needs a warning based on behavior. Child may need reminders to follow rules, procedures and directions or when interacting with other students.

Red-behavior is negative at that time. Child is not following rules, directions or procedures and is negatively interacting with either staff or other students in the room after warnings have been given.

The child is responsible for their chart and places the correct color piece of paper to match their behavior at the time. This is a way to help students regulate their behavior and also be responsible for their behavior.

You will be informed daily of your child's behavior through the "Daily Communication Form" that will go home in your child's folder. Please sign and return each day to ensure consistent home/school communication.
